This is Principal Tim Chipman contacting you with several announcements.

Your students will have lunch at school, as normal, but our STEP classes will dismiss at 12:10pm, our bus/daycare students (minus Westfair Daycare students) at 12:15pm, and all others at 12:20pm.

Fourth, and finally, on Thursday, October 5, Eisenhower will dismiss two hours early for Fall Parent-Teacher Conferences. There will be no student attendance on Friday, October 6 or Monday, October 9.
